



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
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## Foreword

The Westchester County Department of Health (WCDH) plays a leading role in promoting health, preventing disease, and prolonging meaningful life for Westchester County residents. WCDH monitors and controls the spread of communicable diseases, monitors and regulates air and water quality, enforces the state and local sanitary code, promotes local public health activities, and assures the availability of community health services.

To comply with New York State Public Health Law, WCDH in 2013 completed a *Community Health Assessment (CHA) 2013-2017* to describe the health status of Westchester County residents, identify existing gaps and health care barriers, assess the availability and accessibility of health care services, and specify public health priorities in the County. This document is intended to supplement the 2013-2017 CHA with regional health insurance information that was not available in the past. Data are extracted from the American Community Survey (ACS) conducted by the United States Census Bureau.

The ACS is an ongoing nationwide survey designed to provide communities with reliable and timely demographic, social, economic, and housing data for the nation, states, congressional districts, counties, places, and other localities every year. It has an annual sample size of about 3.3 million addresses across the United States (and Puerto Rico) and is conducted in every county throughout the nation (as well as in Puerto Rico). The ACS has asked about health insurance coverage since 2008 and produces estimates for national, state, and local areas annually. Combined with other socio-demographic statistics from this rich source of data, the ACS is a valuable resource for assessing the Affordable Care Act.

## Foreword

The different types of health insurance coverage are broadly classified into either private health insurance or public coverage in the reports generated by the Census Bureau.

#### **Private Health Insurance**

Private health insurance includes the following:

- **Employer-based health insurance**: coverage offered through one's own or a relative's current, or former, employer or union.
- **Direct-purchase health coverage**: purchased directly from an insurance company by an individual or an individual's relative.
- **TRICARE** or other military health coverage: offered through health care programs for active-duty military personnel and retired members of the uniformed services, and their families and survivors.

#### **Public Coverage**


Public coverage includes the following:

- **Medicare**: a Federal program which helps pay health care costs for people age 65 older, and for certain people under age 65 with long-term disabilities.
- Means-tested health care:
  - Medicaid or Medical Assistance: any kind of government-assistance plan for those with low incomes or a disability.\*
  - Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP): a state-level program providing health care to low-income children whose parents do not qualify for Medicaid. (The ACS questionnaire does not specifically ask about this type of coverage, but respondents who indicate this type of coverage are counted as having public coverage.)
  - State-specific plans: Some states have their own health insurance programs for low-income, or for high-risk, uninsured individuals. These health plans may be known by different names in different states. (The ACS questionnaire does not specifically ask about this type of coverage, but respondents who indicate this type of coverage are counted as having public coverage.)
- VA Health Care: a Department of Veterans Affairs program that provides medical assistance to eligible veterans. Those who have ever used or enrolled in VA Health Care are considered covered to have VA coverage.

## Foreword


• Indian Health Service (IHS): a health care program through which the Department of Health and Human Services provides medical assistance to eligible American Indians at IHS facilities. In addition, the IHS helps pay the cost of selected health care services provided at non-IHS facilities. (People whose only health coverage is Indian Health Service are classified by the Census Bureau as uninsured because IHS is not considered comprehensive coverage).

In this document, the information on health insurance coverage status by sex, age, race, and citizenship status are based on the civilian non-institutionalized population. The information on health insurance coverage status by educational attainment is based on the civilian non-institutionalized population 25 years and over. The information on health insurance coverage status by employment status is based on the civilian non-institutionalized population 18 years and over. The information on health insurance coverage status by income level are based on the civilian non-institutionalized population living in households. Data reported are 2009-2013 annual averages.




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
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
## Percentage of Population with Health Insurance Coverage




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



## Percentage of Population with Any Private Health Insurance Coverage
