Do you pay Westchester County sewer taxes but have a septic system?

A Westchester County law could entitle you to be reimbursed for septic system maintenance work.

Kopicki, P.E., Commissioner, Department of Environmental Facilities If your property is in a county sewer district but you have a septic system, a Westchester County law could help cover the cost of your septic tank pump-out and/or septic system inspection performed before August 31, 2026. This law applies to both residential and commercial properties.

How much am I eligible for?

If your property fits the criteria, you can be reimbursed by Westchester County for up to \$300 once every three years for a pump-out of your septic tank. You can also be reimbursed for up to \$275 once every six years for a septic system inspection. Initially, you may choose to do the inspection and pump-out at the same time.

How do I know if my property is in a county sewer district?

Go to the county's interactive website: www.westchestergov.com/map. Put in your address, and then select "Find a County Sewer District." You can also call 211 or your local assessor's office to get the same information.

Who can pump out my septic system?

Only a septic collector who is licensed by the county Department of Health can pump out your septic system. For a list of licensed septic collectors, go to westchestergov.com/health. Click on the A-Z guide under S for Septic Systems and click on the link for *licensed septic* collectors. Or call 211 for the listing.

Who can inspect my septic system?

A professional engineer, a registered architect licensed by the New York State Education Department or a septic system contractor licensed by the Westchester County Department of Health.
