



# Westchester County Board of Health Timeline



**January 7, 1930**

First meeting of the Westchester County Board of Health

**September 1959**  
Promulgates first habitable building standards

**January 1973**  
The entire population of Westchester comes under the jurisdiction of the health dept.



**January 1976**  
Establishes food safety regulations

**January 1990**  
Establishes water pollution standards and controls



**July 1996**  
Bans smoking in public places and smoking sections in restaurants

**June 1999**  
Sets Petroleum Bulk Storage regulations



**October 2010**  
BOH charged with enforcing new county law that requires chain restaurants to post calorie counts



**April 2013**

800th meeting of the Westchester County Board of Health



**September 1959**  
Regulates Milk Safety - Milk must be properly labeled, have a sealed cap and all dairies that do business in the county must comply with NY State Sanitary Codes.



**July 1979**  
Bans smoking in libraries, schools, hospitals and public exhibition halls



**May 1987**  
Regulates exhaust and ventilation emissions and prohibits release of contaminants to improve air quality



**April 1987**  
-Sets 10-day rabies quarantine  
-Establishes Case Reporting and Monitoring for TB, STD and communicable diseases

**March 1992**  
Establishes Children's Summer Camp regulations

**June 1994**  
Requires lead testing for children up to 72 months old

**March 2003**  
BOH charged with enforcing new county law that bans workplace smoking

**June 2006**  
BOH to enforce new county law that regulates the use of tanning salons by minors



**December 2007**  
Bans restaurant use of cooking oils that contain transfat



**November 2008**  
Requires restaurants to post a food allergy notification on menus and menu boards



**December 2012**  
Requires supervision for minors at hotel pools
