No food service establishment will provide single-use foodware or condiment packets to any dine-in or take-away customer unless specifically requested. Items include forks, knives, spoons, chopsticks, cup sleeves, beverage lids and condiment packets or cups. Businesses may not provide bundled single-use items or items by default

Plastic beverage stirrers or splash sticks are no longer permitted
