## Lead in Some Ceramic Pottery

Traditional clay pottery made in some Latin American countries, like Mexico and Ecuador, can contain lead.

To prevent lead poisoning, **DO NOT** use clay pottery for cooking, serving or storing food.

Lead poisoning is dangerous to everyone, but especially children because lead can:

- slow a child's growth
- cause behavioral problems
- affect a child's ability to learn
- cause seizures and death
